The Royal Hotel,

This decidedly Georgian looking hotel was in fact built for the arrival of the railways in Victorian times and the "Royal" prefix was given as a reminder of Queen Victoria's visit to the City of Bath. The Royal commenced trading in 1846

The hotel was designed by the famous architect Brunel, who greatly influenced the architecture in many parts of England in The original name was the "Royal Station Hotel" and because of the growing influence of rail travel and its proximity to the station in 1852, an upper-level footbridge was built directly linking the first floor of the hotel with the station platforms, for the convenience of the hotel guests. The footbridge remained until 1936.
